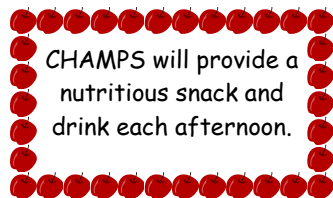
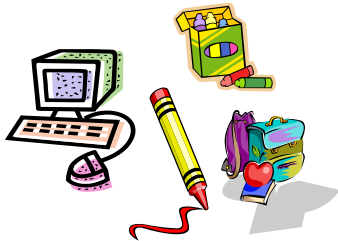

- * Flexible schedules are available. Choose either a 2, 3, 4, or 5 day program.
- * CHAMPS is open on snow delays, early release days and school vacations.
- * Before and After School CHAMPS is located in the Robinson Elementary School, Cafeteria. Children are not transported to another location.
- * CHAMPS is staffed with a Site Coordinator, trained in CPR & First Aid, and Counselors. The child/staff ratio approximately 14:1.
- * All counselors are 18 years of age or older and have been CORI checked.
- * The gymnasium, computer room and outdoor playgrounds are utilized.
- * Age appropriate club activities are offered weekly to allow students to participate in activities that interest them.
