

MILITARY STATUS AS OF June 1, 2015

In May 2012, as part of the VALOR Act, Massachusetts became a member of the Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children. The Compact aims to make the transition to new schools easier for military children in areas such as enrollment, eligibility, placement, and graduation.

The provisions of the Compact apply to students whose Parent/Guardian is currently deployed, discharged from active duty due to a disability, or died while on active duty within the past year.
