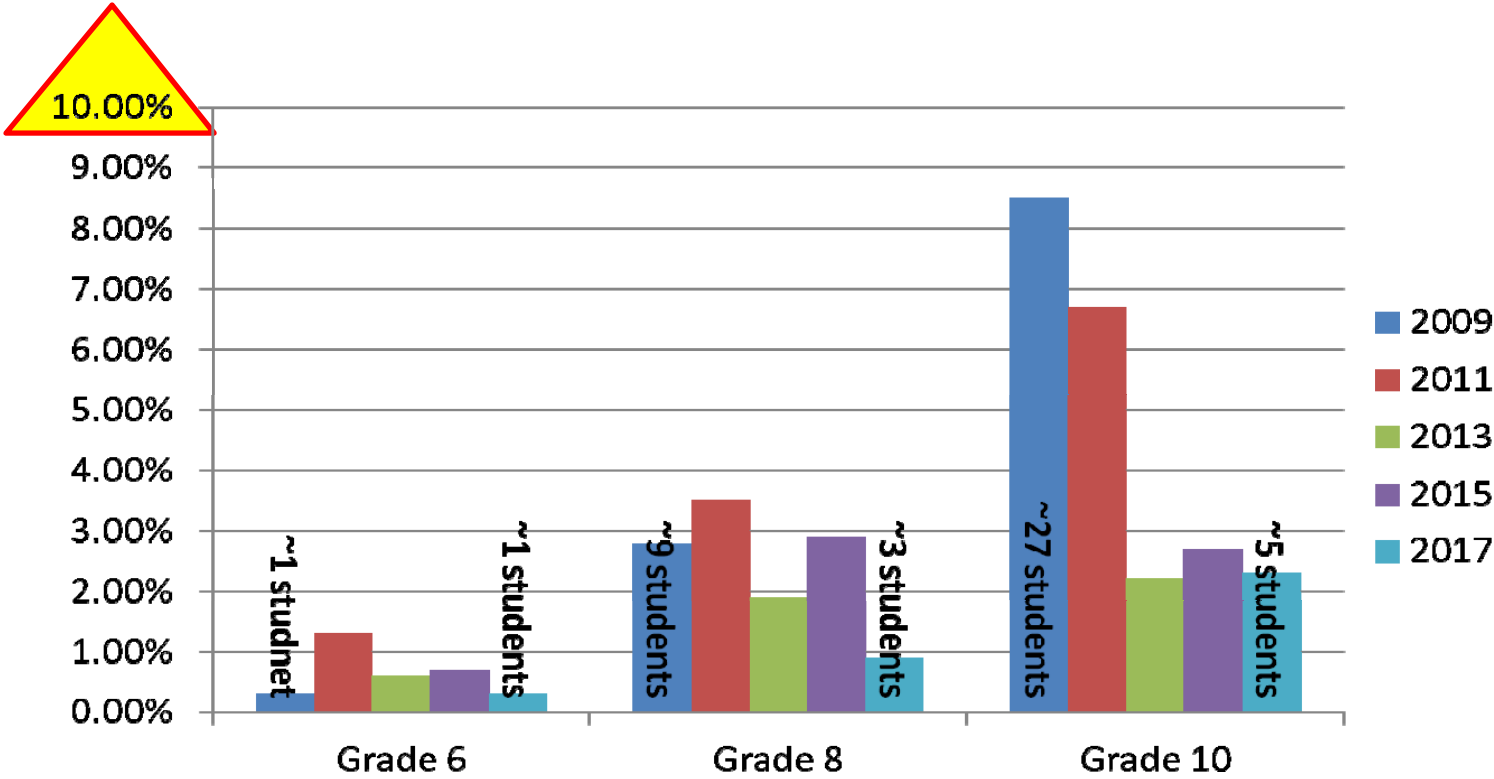

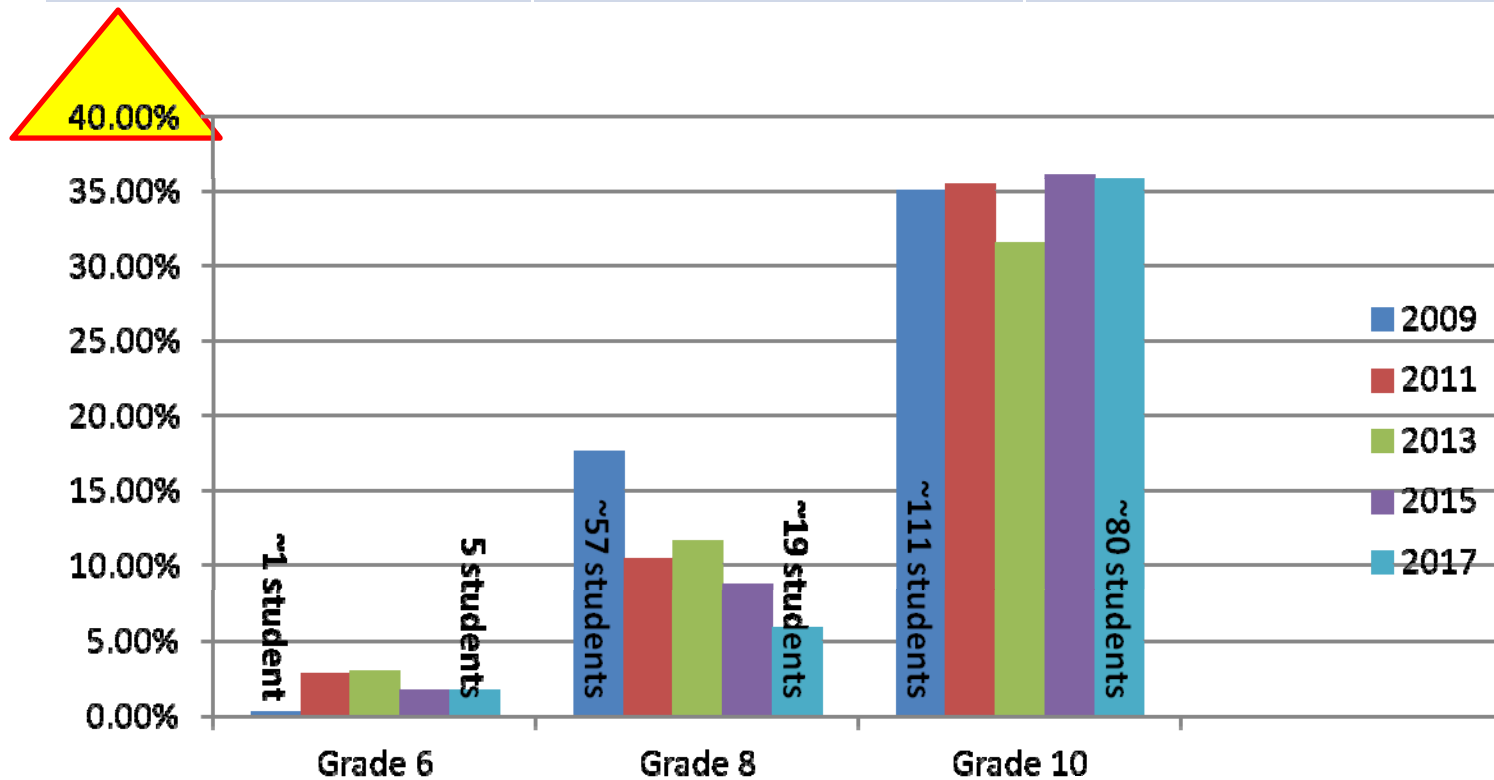

Students Who Have Used Alcohol in the Past 30 Days

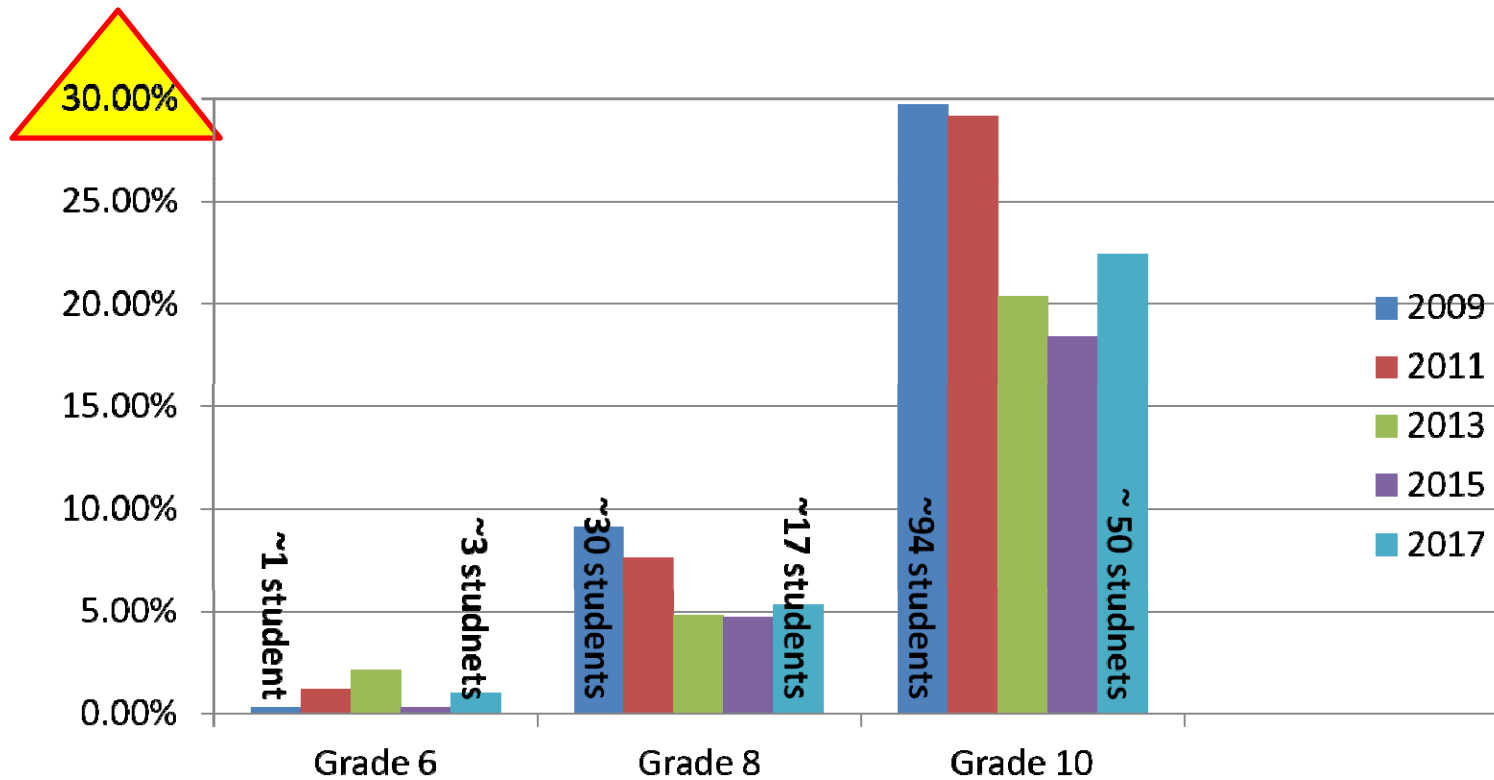

In 2015, the [Monitoring the Future Survey](#) reported that 10% of 8th graders and 35% of 12th graders drank during the past 30 days

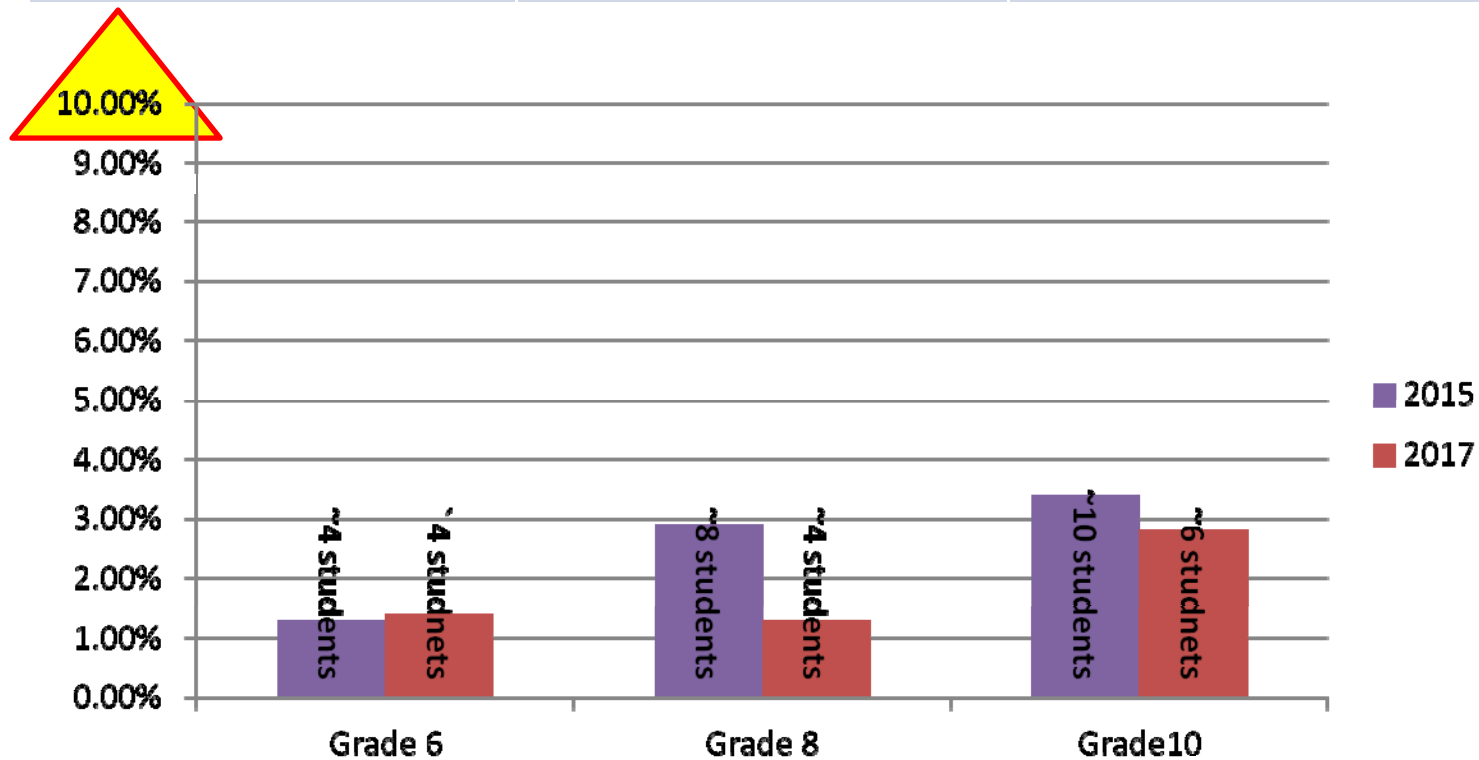

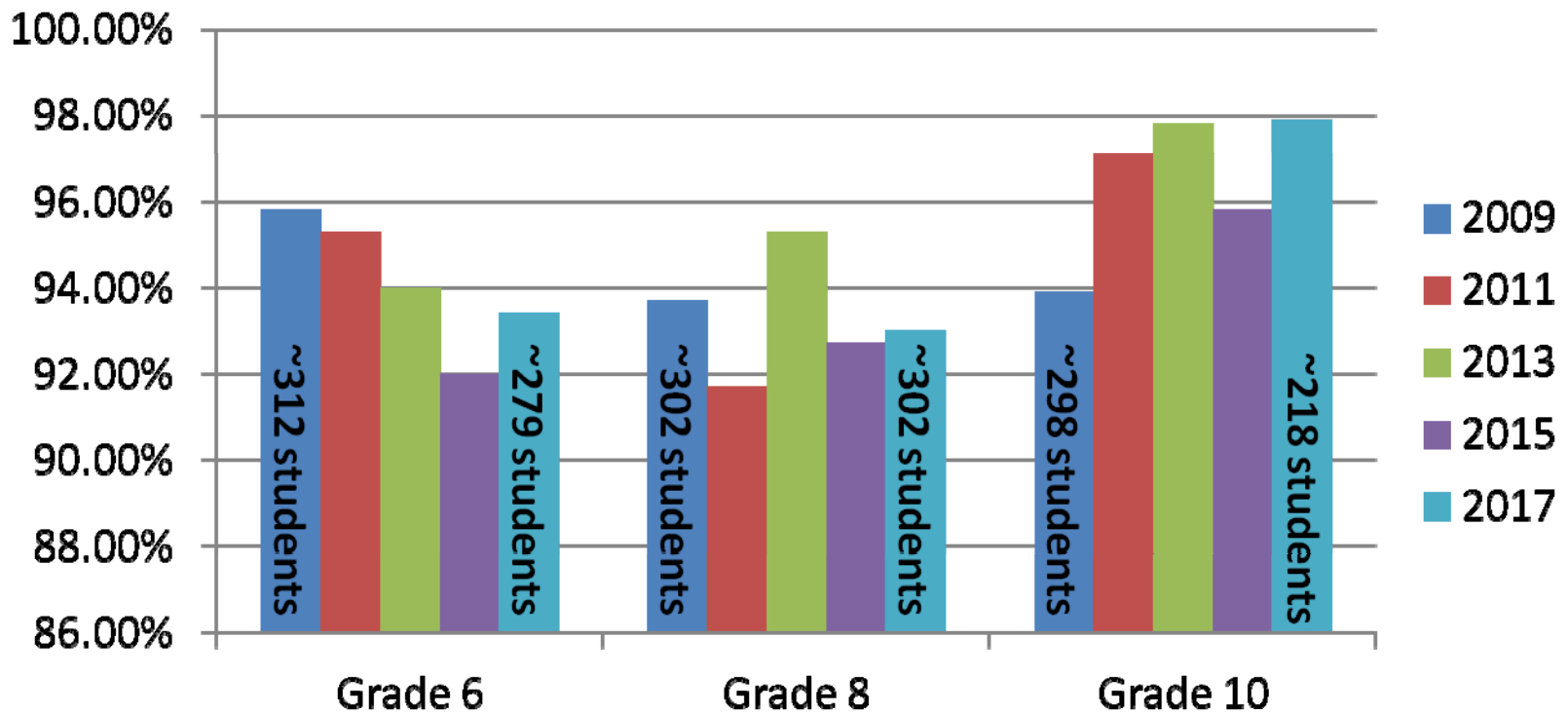

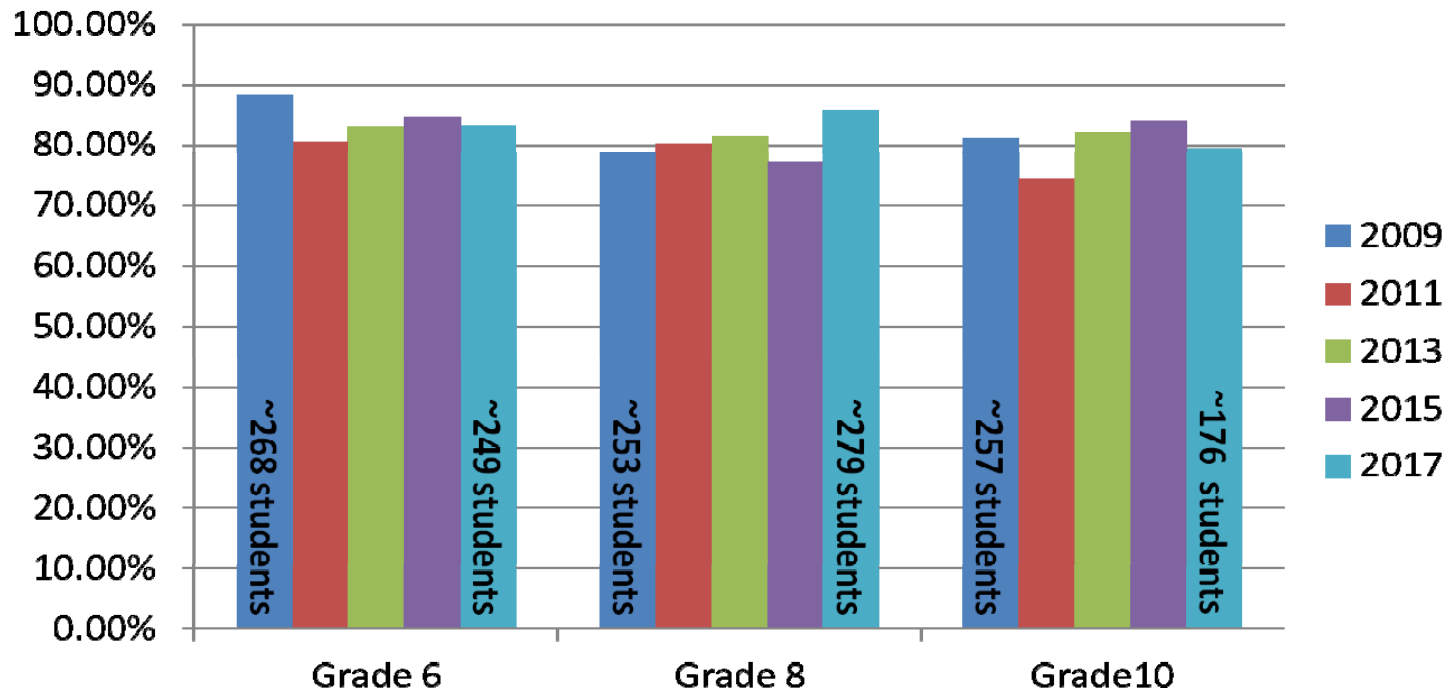

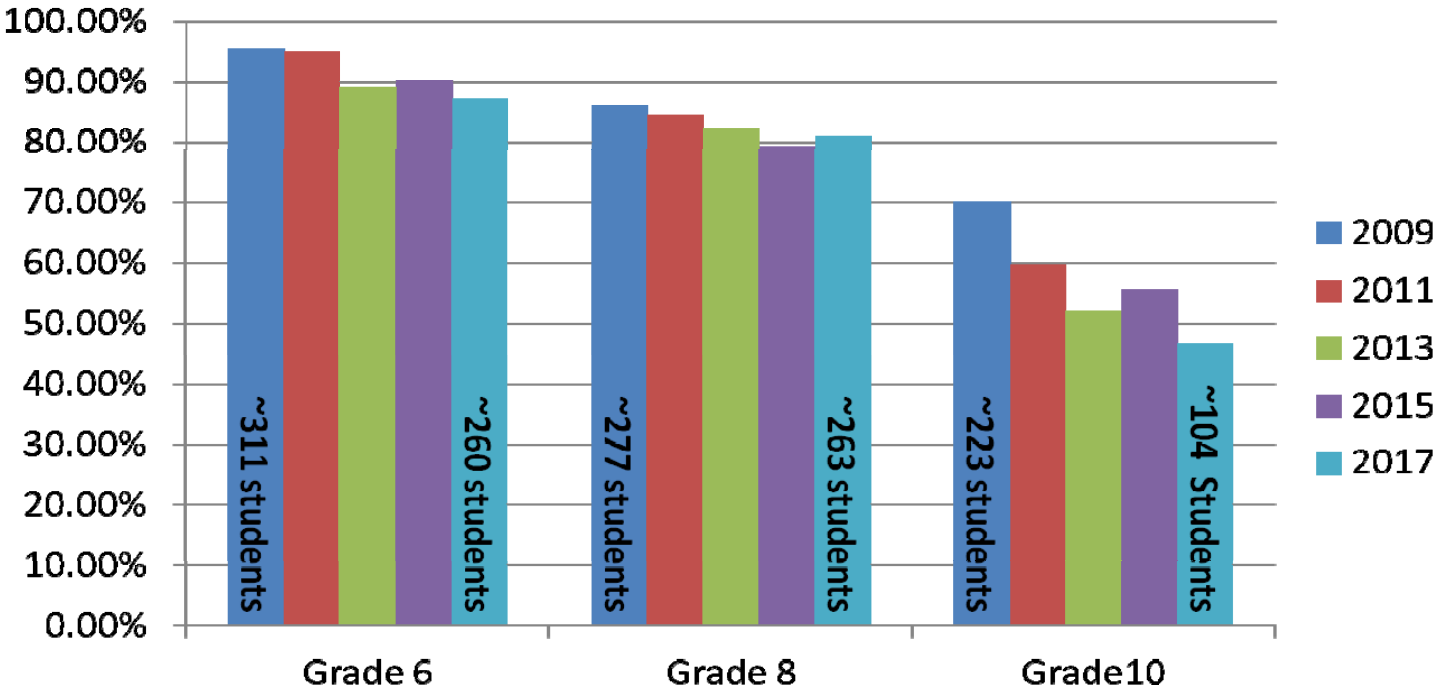

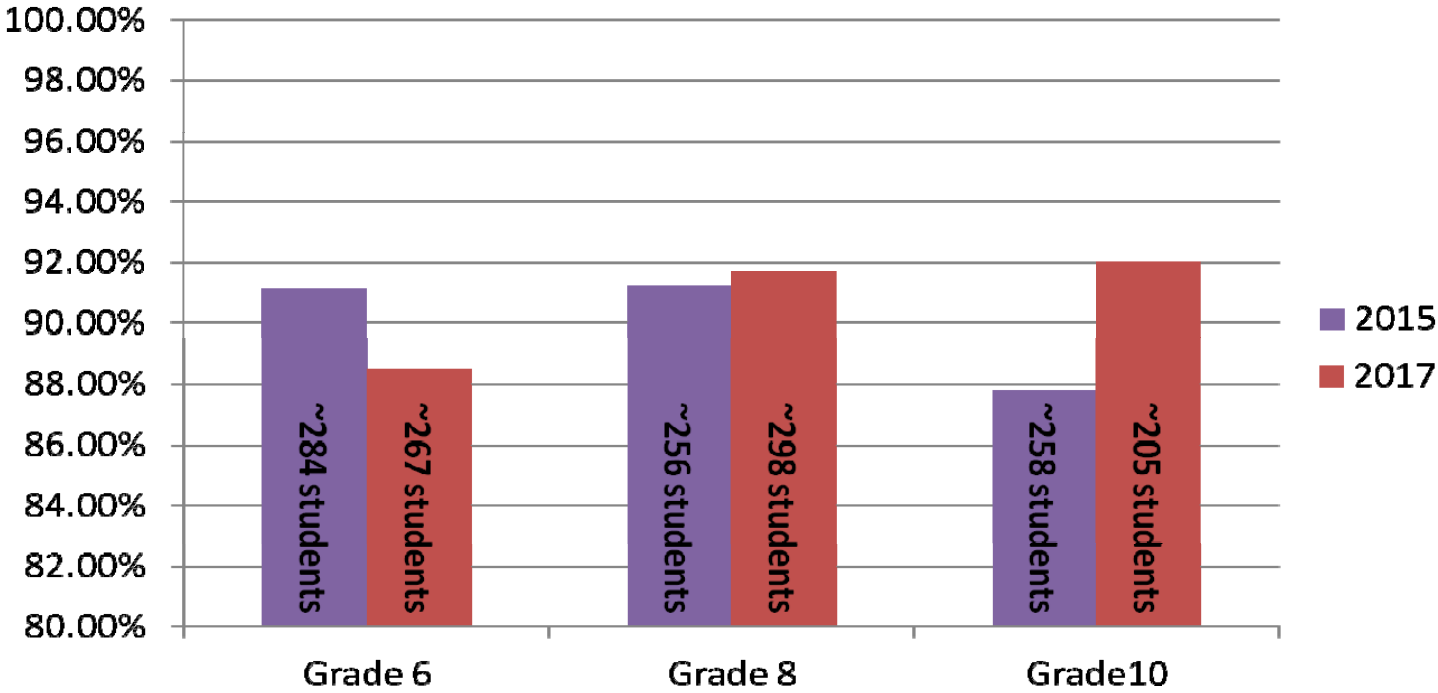

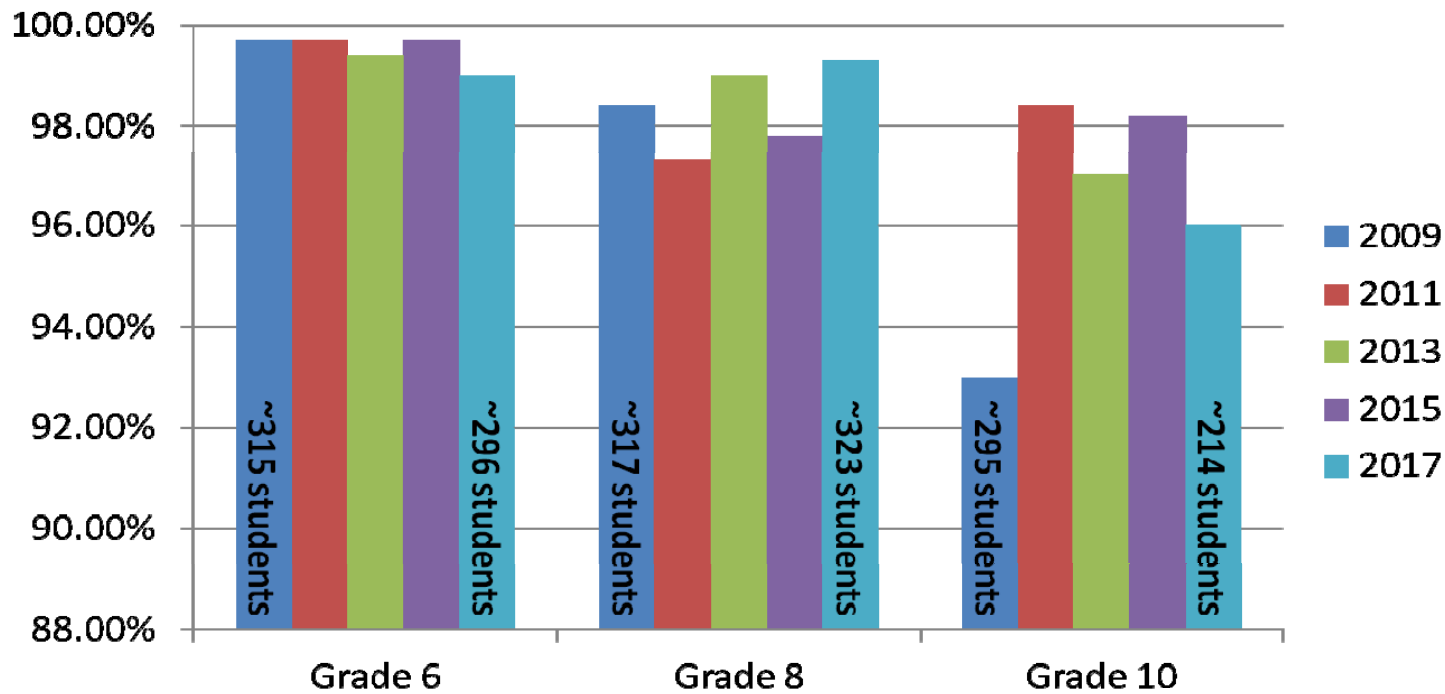

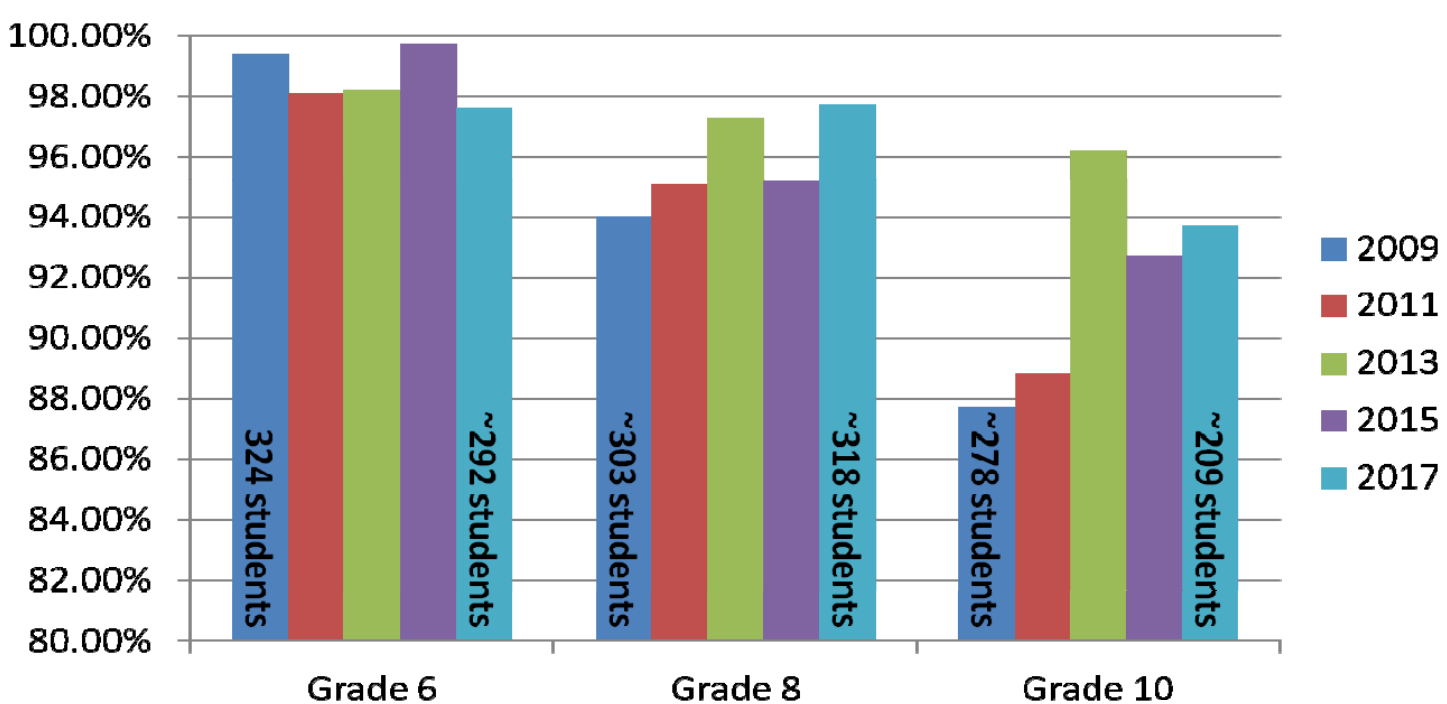

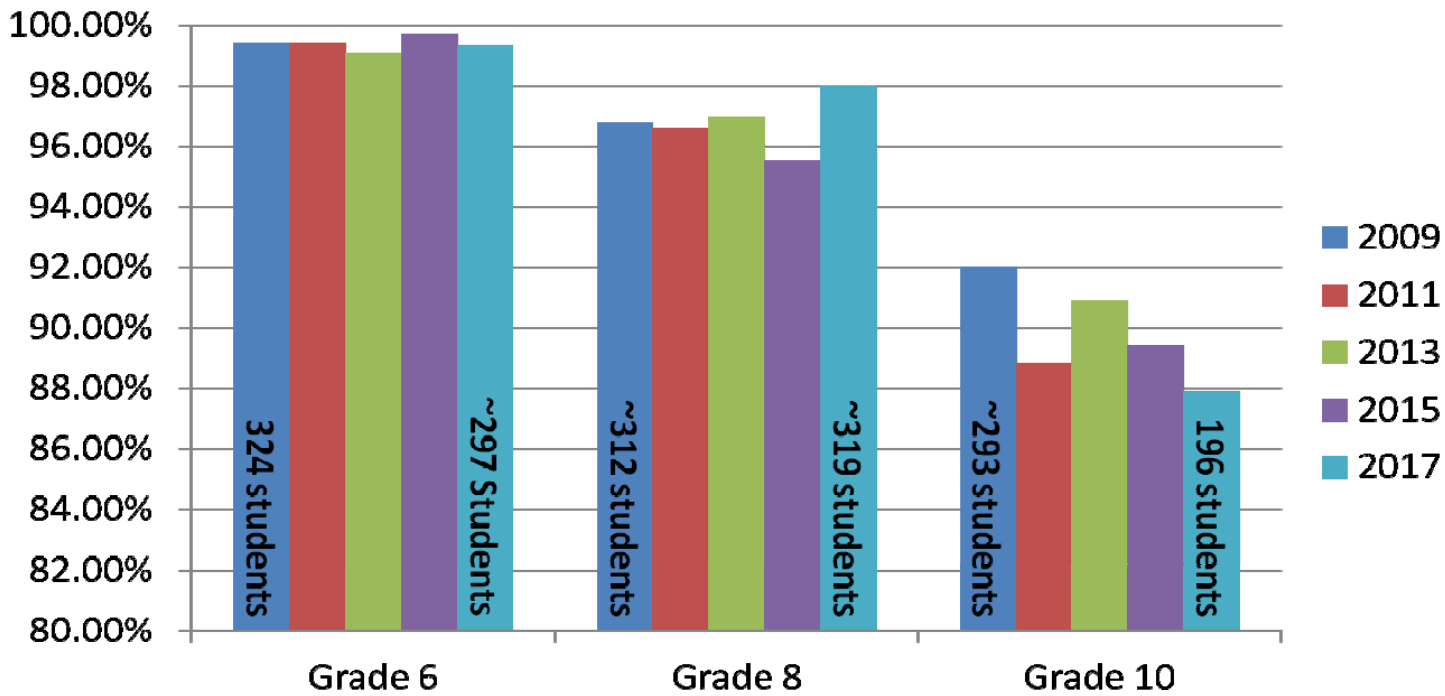

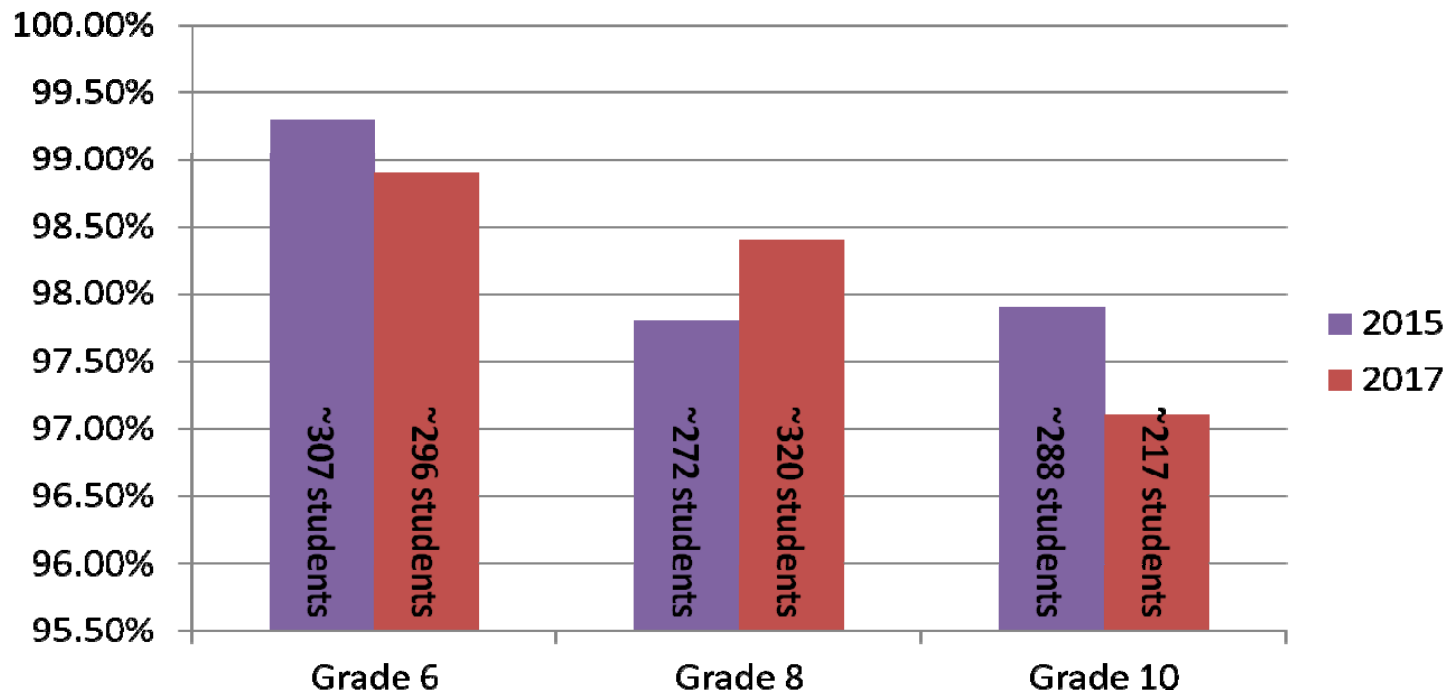

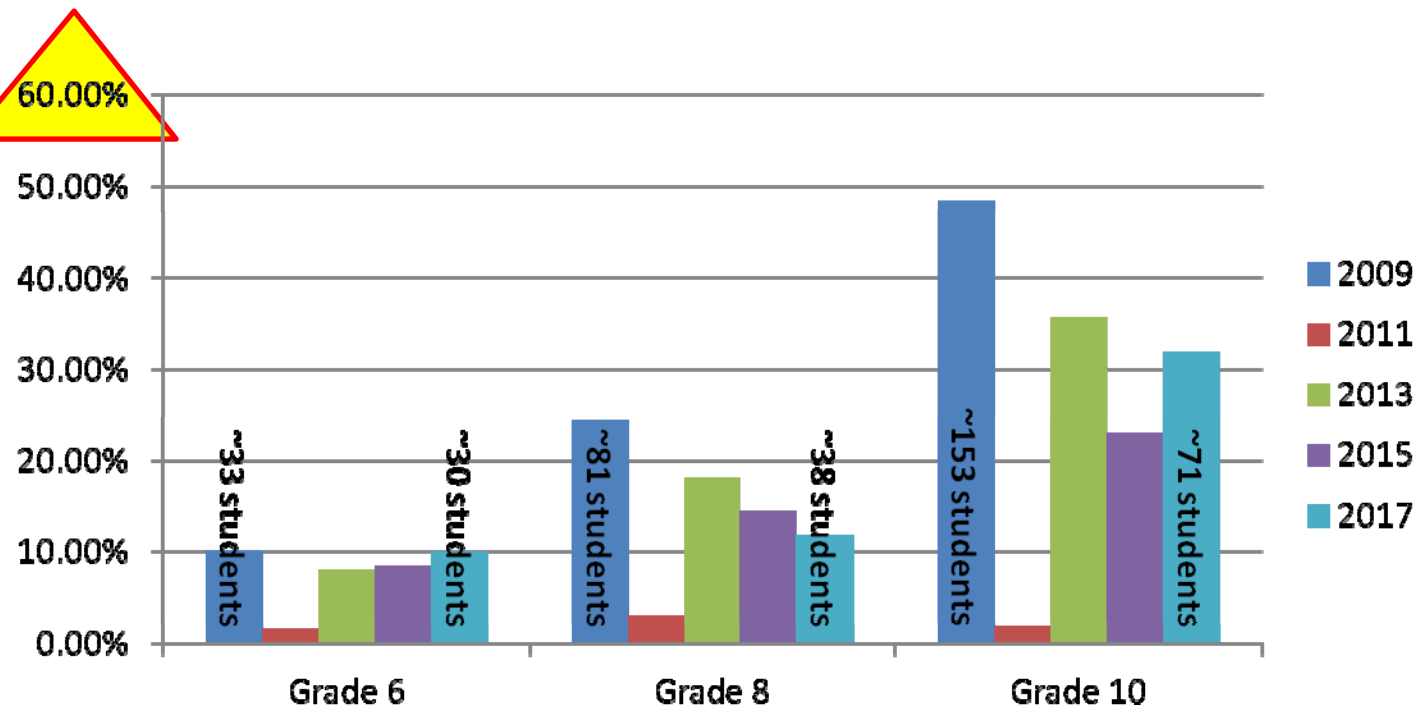

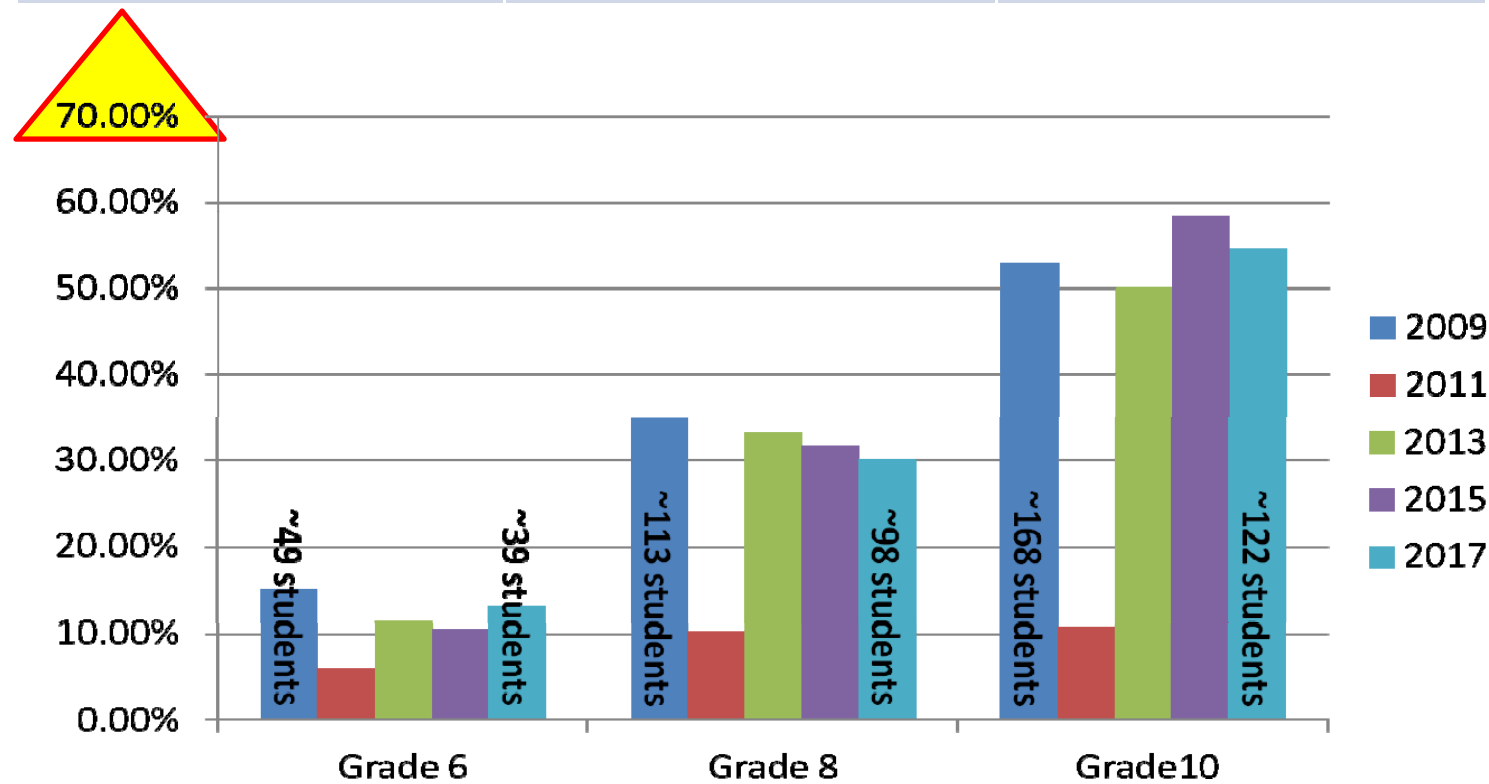

Student Perception of How Easy It Is to Obtain Alcohol

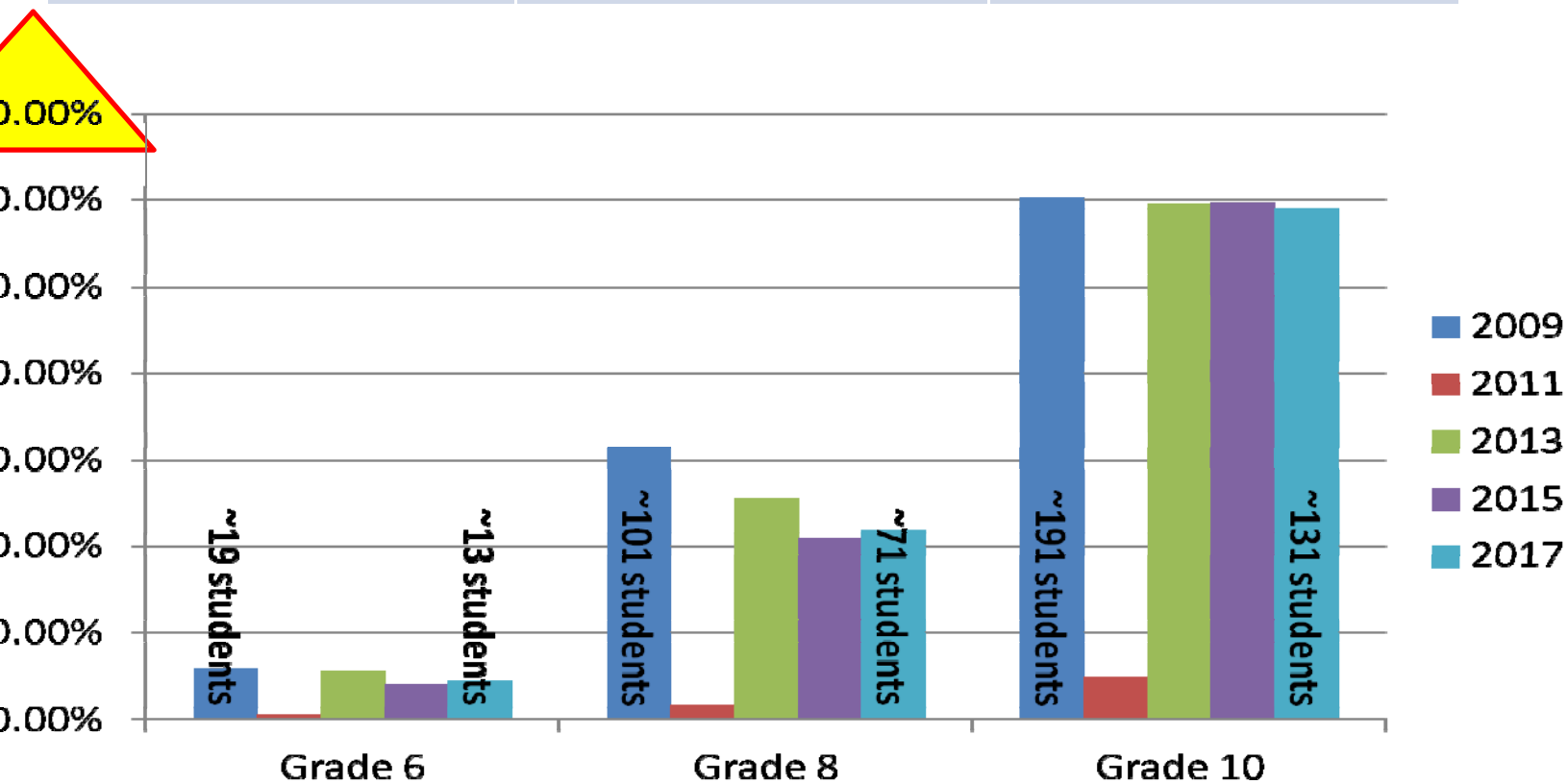

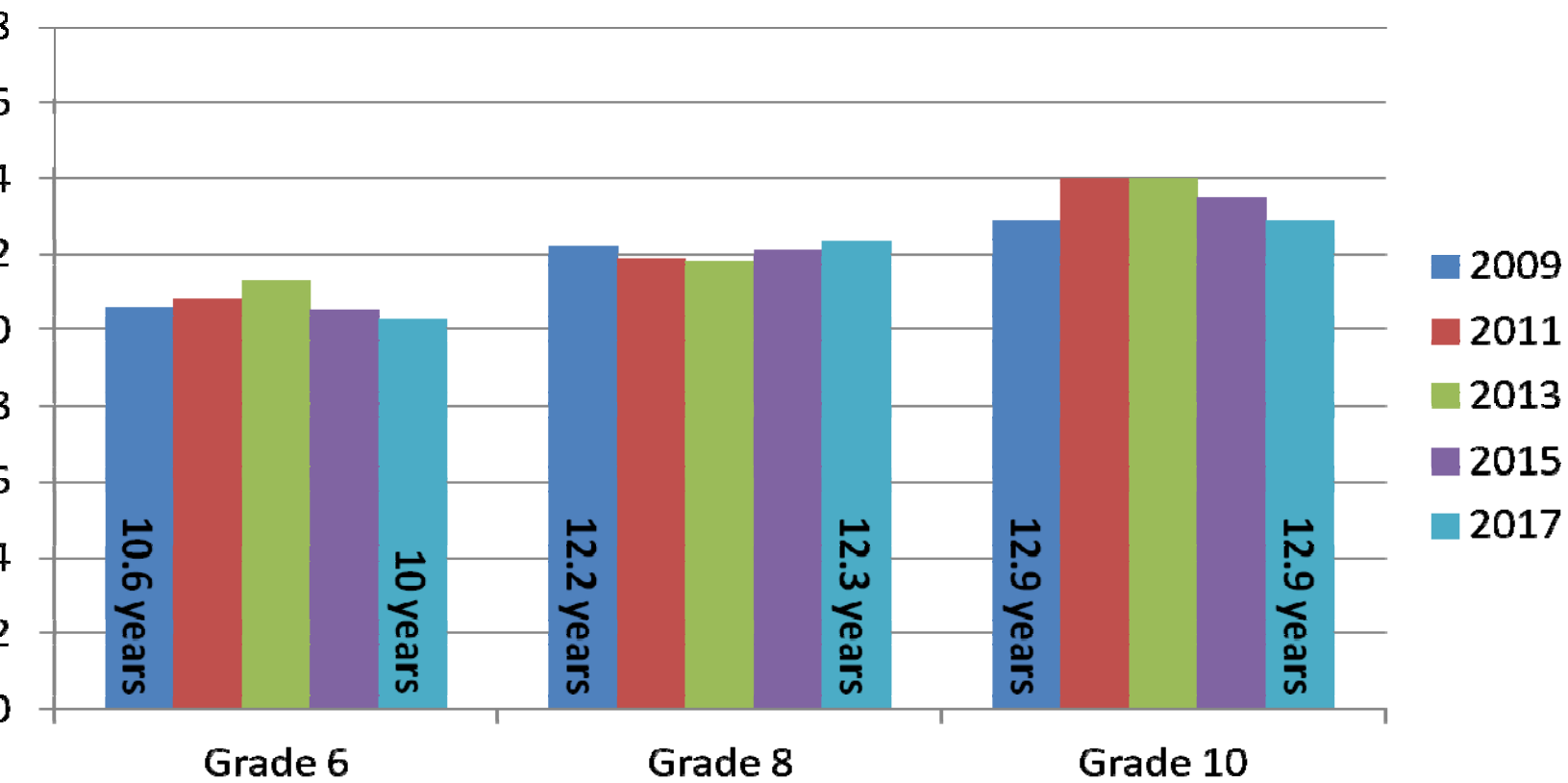

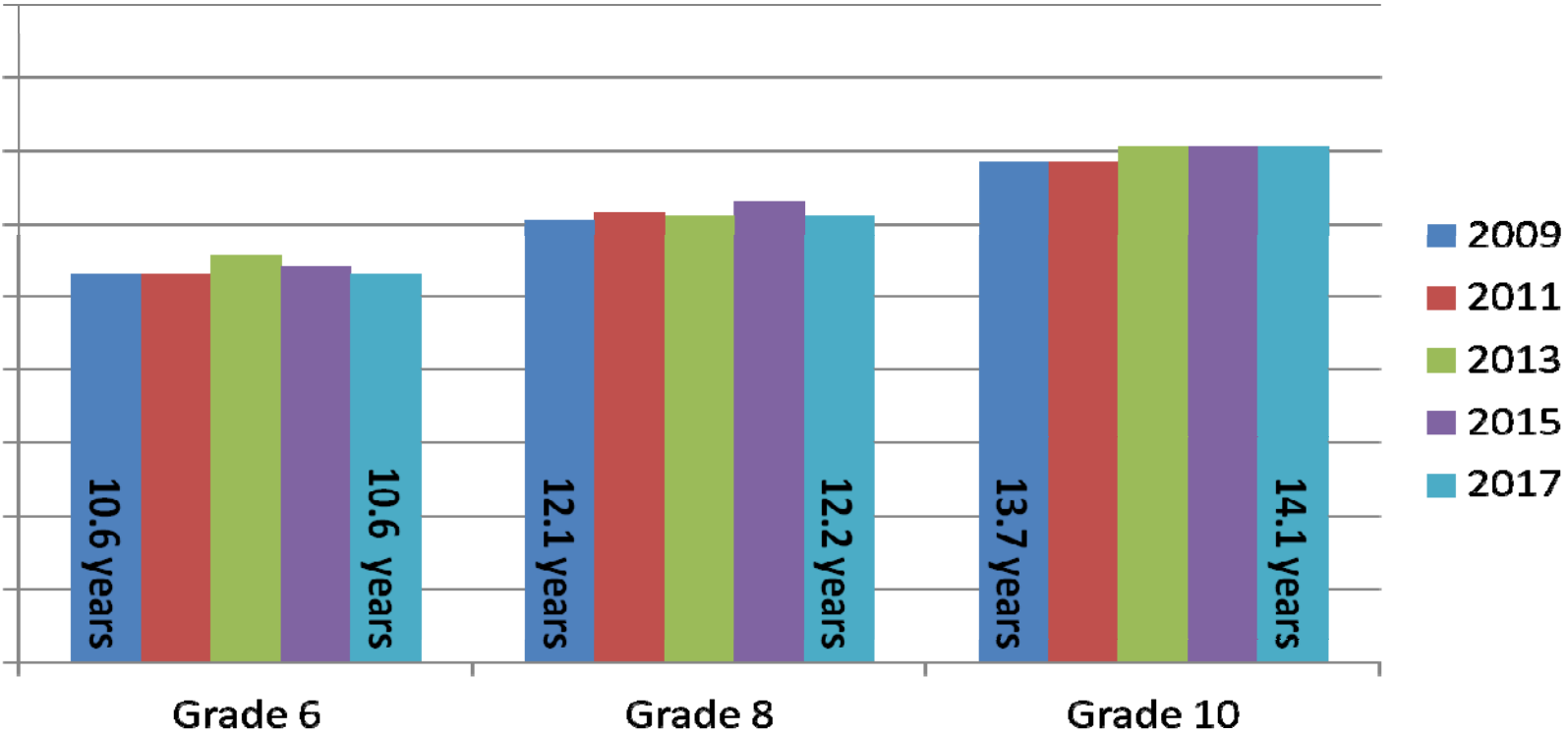

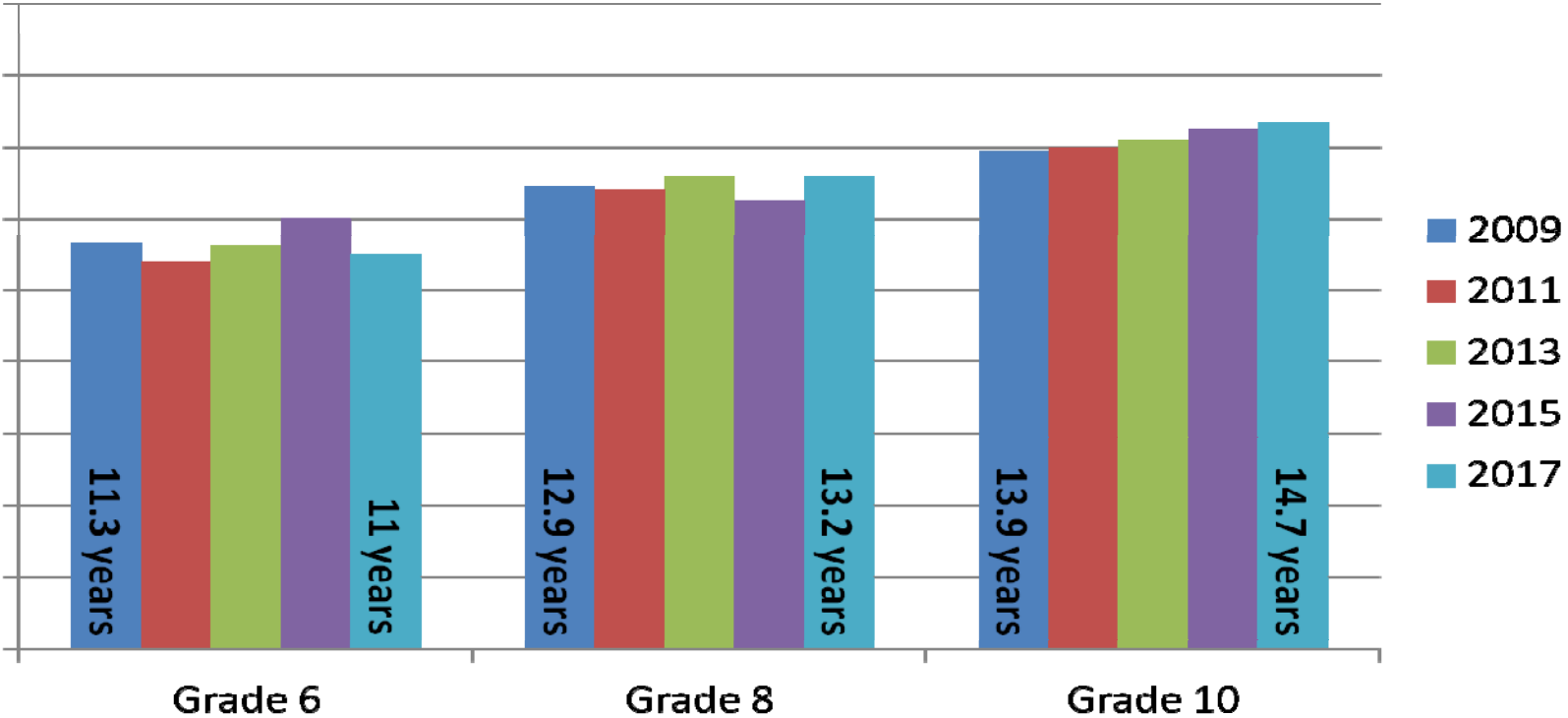
Average Age of First Use: Tobacco
