

DEDICATIONS, MEMORIALS, AND RECOGNITIONS

The Mansfield School Committee acknowledges there are occasions when the school community desires to create a dedication, memorial, or recognition of an individual. All temporary or permanent dedications, memorials, and recognitions must receive prior approval from the Superintendent or designee.

As places designed primarily to support learning, school sites should not serve as the main venue for permanent memorials. Permanent dedications, memorials or recognitions shall be limited to endowments or scholarships. Scholarships and endowments may be established either as one-time or perpetual awards, with a description of the purpose of the endowment or scholarship. The superintendent/designee reserves the right to accept or decline such endowments or scholarships.

Temporary dedications, memorials, or recognitions for individuals that exist for no longer than one month, will be limited to flower arrangements, banners, photos, notes, locker or student desk displays.

Any permanent memorials in existence before the adoption of this policy can only be removed by a vote of the School Committee.
